Note to Parents:

The Abacus Mind Maths course and accompanying workbook are designed to help your child practise essential skills for steady progress in abacus and abacus mind maths techniques. Some lessons may include several pages of homework, but we do not expect this to be completed in one sitting (though your child is welcome to, if they wish!). Instead, we encourage parents to decide how long their child should spend on homework each day.

Our recommendation is to complete 2 or 3 pages at a time when there are more than 2 pages of calculations. This can be spread over multiple days or done in shorter sessions on the same day.

Your involvement in managing homework routines is a valuable way to support your child's learning, helping them build confidence and achieve greater success in the Abacus Mind Maths course.
